Learning a language is a journey best taken through exploration, tactile discovery, and joyful engagement. Vidyanjali Academy for Learning hosted a vibrant two-week Summer Kannada Camp for enthusiastic children aged six and above. The camp started from 6th April to 18th April, 2026. Open to the wider community, the camp focused on strengthening core language skills and building independent reading and

writing confidence. Sessions began with collective phonetic sounds, transitionally moving into object-based activities to connect sounds directly to words. Interactive storytelling and traditional Kannada rhymes boosted active listening, comprehension, and vocabulary. Picture-series exercises sharpened observation, pronunciation, and sequential writing skills. The supportive environment yielded exceptional results, majority of the young participants were reading and writing Kannada fluently and independently.

From 1st to 15th April, 2026, the campus hosted a vibrant Summer Camp designed to keep students active, boost physical fitness, and build essential athletic skills. Each day kicked off with dynamic fitness drills focusing on strength, flexibility, endurance, and coordination, emphasizing the value of a healthy lifestyle. After working up a sweat outdoors, children cooled down with immersive, hands-on art workshops.



Guided by instructors, the children explored colour theory, sketching, and intricate craft designs, letting their imaginations run completely wild on canvas and paper. Students mastered fundamental sports skills, including serving, dribbling, and shooting strategies. Focused drills nurtured teamwork, sportsmanship, and effective communication, while casual matches allowed participants to unwind, socialize, and forge lasting friendships.

What if the true measure of a school is not how many toppers it produces, but how many children it helps succeed?

The Class X Batch of 2025–26 has given a resounding answer to this question. This year, Vidyanjali achieved:

- 100% Pass Percentage
- 100% First Class
- 63% Distinction

What makes this achievement particularly meaningful is that it includes students with diverse learning needs, including students diagnosed with Specific Learning Difficulties (SLD) and symptoms of Dysgraphia. Through individualized support, remedial coaching, continuous monitoring, and

sustained encouragement, every student was able to achieve academic success. The foundation for these results was laid through a structured academic programme that combined regular assessments, revision schedules, multiple pre-board examinations, focused answer-writing practice, and continuous performance tracking. Learning gaps were identified early and addressed through timely interventions and individual guidance.



An important contributor to this success was the introduction of the XSEED curriculum in the lower grades. By encouraging children to think independently, understand concepts deeply, and express ideas in their own words, XSEED helped build strong conceptual foundations. This enabled students to confidently attempt competency-based and higher-order thinking questions in the board examinations instead of relying solely on memorization. Alongside academic preparation,

equal importance was given to students' emotional well-being. Counselling sessions, mentoring programmes, and regular teacher-student interactions helped students remain focused, confident, and resilient throughout the examination year. The support of parents was another key factor in this achievement. Through regular communication and collaboration with the school, parents created a strong support system that reinforced learning and encouraged students to remain committed to their goals. These results are therefore much more than examination statistics. They reflect the combined efforts of students, teachers, parents, and school leadership, as well as Vidyanjali's commitment to inclusive education and meaningful learning.

Staff Training Programmes 2026

Vidyanjali Academy for Learning conducted a rigorous and diverse two-week Staff Training Program from 18th to 30th May, 2026. The program kicked off with a special orientation session which was led by Dr. S. Rekha Reddy for staff members across all departments, alongside targeted policy briefings and subject allocations managed by the school's administration. Educators showcased practical gardening skills, including demonstrations on how to properly

plant a sapling, while others explored culinary creativity by preparing simple, delicious fireless dishes.



The campus buzzed with artistic energy as staff engaged in drawing, vibrant colouring, and intricate craft work. Rhythm and narrative took center stage through lively performances, step-teaching sessions, soulful music, and engaging storytelling.



On Tuesday, 19th May, faculty then attended a crucial session on POCSO and student mental wellness conducted by Mrs. Darsana Niranjana, Director of Mental Wellness at Githam Consulting Pvt. Ltd. The afternoon was dedicated to CBSE-specific updates including the Middle School Holistic Progress Card (HPC), Computational Thinking and AI, and the new Class IX

curriculum before launching into Annual Lesson Planning. On Wednesday, 20th May, 2026 teachers collaborated on integrating AI tools into the classroom environment.



During the afternoon, a vital, hands-on First Aid training session was conducted by Dr. Faranghees Yusuff Khan from the Emergency Medicine department at Baptist Hospital to ensure campus-wide safety readiness. The middle segment of the training balanced technical proficiency with community engagement, financial literacy, and pedagogical strategy.

The remainder of the day saw teachers designing creative display boards for their respective classrooms, corridors, and the front office.

On Monday, 25th May and Tuesday, 26th May, 2026, teachers focused on designing Bridge Courses and attended an advanced workshop on creating question papers aligned with Blooms Taxonomy. Concurrently, select faculty groups underwent intensive Creya Training in the Science Lab to enhance experiential learning.

On Wednesday, 27th May, 2026 Ms. Shabeena led the CBSE teaching staff through targeted XSEED Subject Demonstrations to refine active learning methods in the classroom. On Friday, 29th May the program wrapped up with teachers finalizing classroom arrangements for the children's return. This intensive professional development journey didn't just sharpen teaching skills; it sparked fresh ideas and strengthened the collaborative bond among the faculty.
